GTA 2: Cyberbullying awareness

Learning objectives:

- Understand what cyberbullying is and its impact on individuals
- Develop an anti-cyberbullying campaign to promote awareness and prevention

Working method: class and pairs.

Resources and materials: paper and pen, internet, student's book

TASK 1**Warm-up: Class discussion**

a. Reflect upon the question “Have you ever seen or heard about cyberbullying?”

b. Discuss real-life examples of cyberbullying that you have seen or heard about (without naming people).

→ Transition to TASK 2 having in mind the importance of understanding this issue.

TASK 2**Case study: Real-life cyberbullying**

a. Watch the following two videos about real-life cases of cyberbullying. You can ask a teacher to project the videos in your classroom

1. [Roseanna's cyberbullying story](#)





2. Emma's Story: Cyberbullied by a Best Friend



b. In pairs, **answer** the following questions:

- What happened to Roseanna and Emma?
- How did Roseanna and Emma react? How did they deal with the situation?
- What are the main messages they both leave in the end?

c. Each pair **shares** their ideas with the class and **identify** possible effects of cyberbullying, and how it can be prevented.

Take notes. You may need them for the following task.

- As an alternative, you can **look for** a text on the topic of real-case cyberbullying in your student's book, read it and do the reading activities . In the end, ask a teacher to check your answers.

TASK 3

Create an Anti-Cyberbullying Campaign

In small groups, **create** an anti-cyberbullying campaign.

Ask the Citizenship Teacher/Coordinator in your school to help or guide you, if needed.

For your campaign, you can:

- **Design a poster** with a slogan and key messages
- **Create** a social media **post**.
- **Record** a short **video** raising awareness.

▪ Guiding questions:

- What is your main message?
- Who is your audience?
- How can you make it effective?
